Edgewood Children's Center	330 N. Gore Webster Groves	Residential treatment for emotionally disturbed children. Children 6-15 1/2 yrs stay for on avg 18-22 mths. Day program for autistic children ages 3-12 yrs.  Directions: Hwy 40 to S on McKnight; road turns into Rockhill past Manchester; once on the grounds, drive to Jones Training Ctr, parking near bldg, main entrance. Look for Volunteer Office
Empowerment Center	3024 Locust St.	Full service community-based peer drop-in center serving the chronically mentally-ill and homeless Self-help groups, recreation, hot meal at lunch
Hawthorne Children's Psychiatric Hospital	1901 Pennsylvania	Inpt treatment of severely emotional disturbed children 6-18. Staff includes all types of clinical personnel to develop individualized treatment program.
Independence Center <a href="http://www.independencecenter.org">www.independencecenter.org</a>	4245 Forest Park	Adult Psych Rehabilitation. Clubhouse model, outpt, partial clinic, & residential care facilities. Provides vocational/career counseling, socialization, transitional employment, housing, and treatment for the severely mentally ill.
Lakeside Center (School for Delinquent Boys)	13044 Marine Av	Provides individual, group and family treatment, psychiatric and psychological consultation, education, recreation and medical care for disturbed adolescents.
Metropolitan Employment and Vocational Service	Various Sites in StL metro area	Provides vocational rehabilitation for persons with physical, mental, emotional, social, or cultural disabilities. Educational counseling and information, independent living skills training, and residential fac.
Marygrove	2705 Mullanphy Lane	Residential treatment center for children, from birth to 21. Most residents are adolescents.

Miriam School for Learning Problems	501 Bacon	Day school for children ages 3-9 with mild to moderate learning disabilities, behavior disorders, or developmentally delayed.

Places for People	4130 Lindell	Residential treatment for homeless people a model for similar programs in other states.
Preferred Family Healthcare	2639 Jefferson & Miami (former St. Alexius)	Residential counseling, treatment, and rehabilitation program for drug and alcohol abuse.
St. Patrick's Center	800 N Tucker St	Day programs, work training, health education, and other programs for people with severe mental illness
McMurphy's Grill (Can be combined w/St. Patrick's)	614 N 11th St	Operated by St. Patrick's - work training for homeless or severely mentally ill people. Trainees learn every facet of the business and are placed in food service jobs after a 6 mth training period.
Touch Point Autism Services (Formerly known as: Judevine Center)	1101 Olivette Executive Pkway	Provides various services including testing, counseling, parenting education, group homes, consultation and respite care.
